Based on a hand-wound calibre with a 42-hour power-reserve, the watch displays the time in six different metropolises and the local time. Its case of 44 mm emphasises the persuasive prominence of the "7 Time Zones" model. The lavishly finished movement reflects state-of-the-art craftsmanship. Available in a classic or a sporty version, this new timepiece offers unparalleled convenience for frequent travellers as well as for people who communicate on a global scale.
